The Winter School aims to explore and invent the urban with the method of documentary filmmaking and (sound-) field-recording as media to provide new insights and readings of the contemporary city. Students from the carriers Architecture and Urbanism, Film, Cultural Studies, Psychology, Music, Arts, Design, Social Sciences, Geography, Journalism, and related fields are warmly invited.

Language

The course will be taught in English. Appropriate language skills are required.
